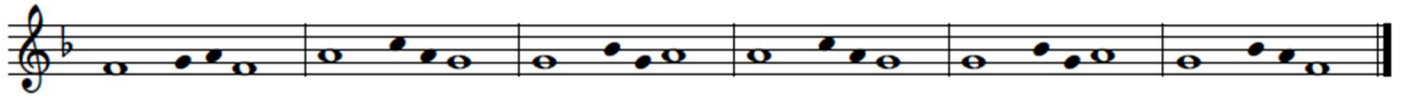

and swiftly runs his command.

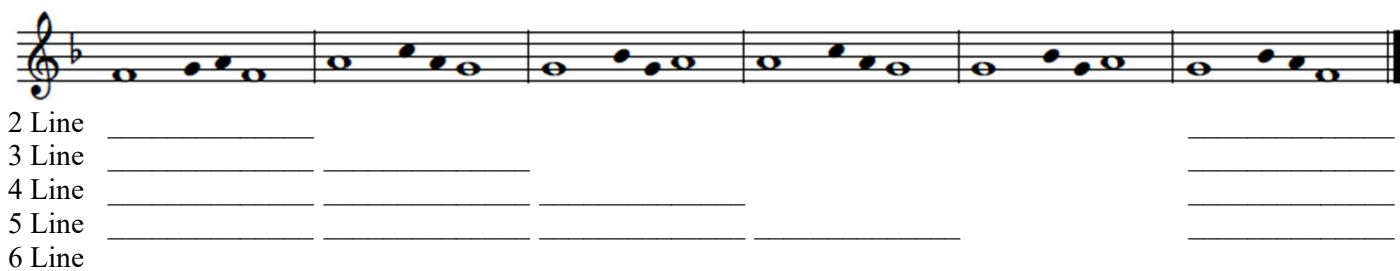

and his deeds to the children of Israel.

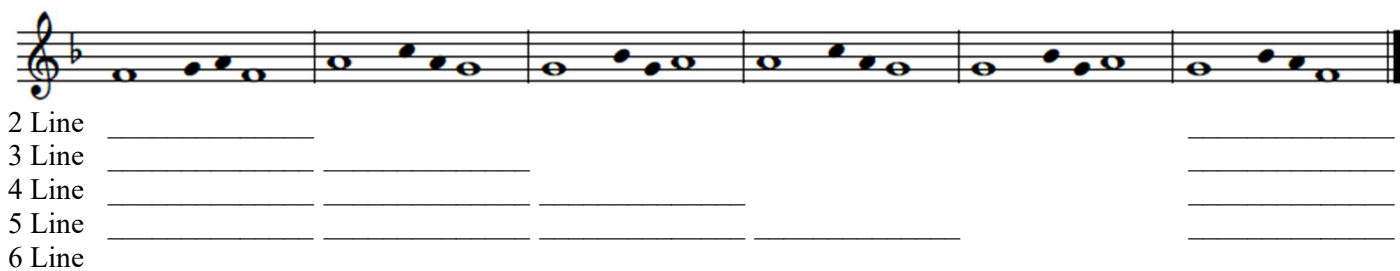
